# Hotel Sid



Danos installed site-specific Cajun Coral (ExoForms™) to restore vital marine habitat and recreational fishing environment near Grand Isle, La. The installation replaced a lost marine habitat with a vibrant, sustainable habitat that will serve both marine life and anglers for generations to come.

## GOALS

- Restore vital marine habitats, benefitting a wild range of species and rejuvenating an ecosystem.
- Enhance fishing opportunities, supporting both the local fishing community and the broader economy of Grand Isle.
- Provide sustainable growth of natural habitat, promoting long-term ecological health that will strengthen over time.

## RESULTS

- Custom Cajun Coral created more than 10,000 square feet of living reef.
- Project included more than 500 Cajun Coral each weighing more than 400 pounds.
- Restored vital marine habitat that was lost after the removal of a decommissioned oil and gas platform known as Hotel Sid.
- Created complex structure and habitat for a variety of aquatic organisms including popular recreational species like redfish, speckled trout, black drum, sheepshead and flounder.
